SUMMARY OF ARGUMENT

A. Nature of Case.

The Petitioner, Stanley Siler, appearing pro se, filed a Class Action Allegation Complaint, Personal Injury Action 28 U. S. C. §1332 and Copyright Infringement Action Title 17 U. S. C. § Copyrights, naming Dillingham Ship Repair, Sedgwick of Oregon, Inc., Barry Groce, Bruce A. Bottini and Emery and Sons Construction, Inc.

B. Course of Proceedings.

Respondents file Motion to Dismiss in the courts below. Respondents argue that complaint is harassing and frivolous. The Petitioner “WON” in United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit case 07-35413. Case was Vacated, Reversed, and Remanded to The United States District Court of Oregon, Civil No 06-1693-HA. The Petitioner gave NOTICE to all parties, which is required by law, Title 17 U. S. C. § Copyrights * Section 501(a)(b). The Supreme Court of the United States has jurisdiction, Title 28 § 1257(a).

C. Facts.

Petitioner, Stanley Siler has enough evidence in compliance to the Fifth Amendment of the United States Constitution for presentment and indictment by the Grand Jury in Petitioner’s registered copyright documents. Title 17 U. S. C. § Copyrights * Section 205(c)¹. The

Petitioner's registered documents are voluminous. The Supreme Court of the United States has subject matter in both personal and territorial jurisdiction. [Registration by Subject Matter § Title 17 U. S. C. § Copyrights].

CONCLUSION

The petitioner asks for punitive damages, statutory damages and (*unpaid*) mandatory damages that the parties are negligence in paying. Continuous the parties are infringing the Petitioner. Petitioner request action to be tried by the full record. Petitioner, furthermore, asks for a seizer pursuant to Title 17 § Section 509(a)(b). All copies manufactured, reproduced, distributed, sold, or otherwise used, intended for use, and possessed in violations of Copyright Law Title 17 * Section 506(a) All plates, molds, matrices, masters, tapes, filmed negatives, or other articles by means of which such copies or phono records may be reproduced, and all electronic, mechanical, or other devices for manufacturing, reproducing, or assembling such copies or phono records are seized and forfeited to the United States², just compensation in the amount of five billion dollars.
